Announcement: Chinese Utahans' Action Proposal for Fighting COVID-19

On March 21, 2020, Twenty Utah Chinese and Asian community organizations jointly released an action proposal for their members to support statewide efforts to control COVID-19 spread among Utahans. The statement asks Chinese and Asian communities to follow the Governor and local officials' COVID-19 guidance; protect their own family, help each other and neighbors; provide voluntary services for seniors and donate disinfection supplies to vulnerable populations; and donate funds or medical supplies such as face-masks to health or charity organizations. Chinese and Asian Utahans should work side by side with all Utahans to help mitigating the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. We will ultimately win this battle to achieve "Health for All and Peace for All."
